- All participants will be requested to complete a brief orientation process with one of the team leaders prior to working in the computer lab.
- No food or drink is allowed at the computer stations. However, you are free to eat and drink in the Café area as you visit with your friends. A free-will donation box is provided for the daily refreshments.
- Black and white copies can be made for a charge of 5 cents per copy. A box will be near the printer

for you to drop in your change. Please come prepared with change when you are expecting to make copies.
